We are a very forward thinking practice and embrace changes to try to improve our working day. Our staff undertake Document Management which has reduced our Docman letters by >80%. We are also improving Signposting at the front desk to reduce unnecessary GP contacts. We work closely with the local Cluster to cultivate safe and effective medical practice.

## **The Team**

From May 2019 we will have 5 partners and one salaried GP. One of our partners has a seat on Forth Valley Health Board and is closely in touch with local and national health and social care strategy.

We are a Training Practice affiliated to Tayside and routinely have GP registrars attached to the practice. Two of our Partners are GP Trainers. We also enjoy hosting final year Medical Students from Dundee University on a regular basis.

Our practice team includes our Advanced Nurse Practitioner with triaging and minor illness skills, Practice Nurse, HCAs, a Mental Health Nurse and a Joint Advisory Specialist. The practice also has an experienced Staff Nurse who supports our Nursing Homes.

We have attached Community Nurses and Health Visitors based on our premises. In addition we have input from visiting Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Midwifery and Podiatry colleagues. There is a supportive and very friendly team of administrative staff.

We meet targets easily and have efficient systems in place, but are always open to ideas and trying to improve our practice.
